1. Food Share - Sherry Hill/Anne Clapp

- Anne Clapp attend the meeting to help make the decision around whether/how SAC can support Food Share and if hot lunch is one of those ways
- Currently there are 9 students who have daily bagged lunches that would receive a slice of pizza every other week
- \$4000 available for food sharing from donations/parent's council donation
- Council voted to provide Food Sharing with 1 cheese pizza every pizza day (approximately \$16 every other week)

2. School/Principal's Report

- Busy month!
- Uptick in behaviours perhaps due to anxiety around the holidays
- Uptick in student/staff absences but there are no new Covid guidelines
- Received full \$1000 for Math Night Thursday, April 4
- Mohawk language class currently 3 are enrolled, it's online and our participation is the highest in the board
- Book Fair earned around \$6000, ran by Suzanne Shefield, total sales were about \$10000
- Volleyball, Drama production and Bus Safety Presentations have all been successful
- Class pictures will be taken tomorrow
- French concert for students will take place next week, a francophone performer from Sarnia area is performing for students

- Primary Holiday Concert will be performed twice during the day, an evening concert has typically seen low attendance by students
