IV. Principal's Report: Greg Seiveright

- EQAO report passed out
- Take away as a school: structured literacy has really paid off with the primary grades, need to keep focusing on math (might take a while to show an impact), need to recognize the cohort changes (grade 6 would potentially have had more of an effect from pandemic; would not have done grade 3 testing), need to recognize that EQAO is a province-wide assessment vs. being a true assessment of progress
- Summary of attendance reviewed
 - Ministry want 90% of students attending 90% of days; currently we are at 90% of students attending 80% of days. * one of the Ministry's priority
- BRAVE Education (Social and Emotional Toolkit) is a program that comes into schools (at a cost)
 - Anti-bullying, messages on how to deal with conflict, workshops for kids or families, role-play, tends to be well received with some schools in the Limestone District doing it, likely couldn't come out of school funds (likely too expensive)
- Attempted to book an OPP officer last year; have a new safety officer; do we want to look into it again this year; ? topics, offer a night with various stations of topics for parents
- Bookfair: November 25-29th, has asked for volunteers Susanne Sheffield.

V. Teacher Representative's Report: Amy Kennedy-York

a. Teacher's Wish lists-created a Google doc that will be sent around (ex. outdoor learning spaces, flexible seating options, books (ex. Book-fair money to the teachers from parent counsel); Amy Kennedy-York to share Google doc with the team.



- **b. Flexible Seating**-most staff very interested in the flexible seating options, OT suggested the same ones that have been suggested
- Sports Jerseys- a way to make money back by using the e-store (communicated to the teachers)
