IV. Principal's Report: Greg Seiveright

- PRO-Grant: the past 2 years (Parent's Reaching Out)-increase engagement with families; increase the connection between school and home; bringing families into the schools-last 2 years used the money for Family Math Night (most families go home with a board game). Use for up to \$1000.
- Family Literacy Day (Monday January 27th); doing a literacy week; build a bookworm (every time they read more books, they build the snake; Mystery Reader challenge; different events all week (Read the Room, Drop Everything and Read, Dress as your favourite book character day)- focus on Literacy
- Community Partner's Night- got ahold of our Community OPP Officer (Online Awareness, Social Media), Public Health Nurse (Raising Mentally Healthy Kids), Maltby Centre (Addictions-gaming, etc.); community carousel night (30-45 minutes), 3-4 options for parents to attend, can attend up to 2 sessions + kiosks (Library, Boys and Girls Club, Harmony Music Club, LARC, SAC, etc.); looking at dates now (March 6th)
 - BRAVE program is another option (\$155/class or \$600 for parent presentation);
 ? 2 grades, ~6 classes (conflict resolution)- an extra layer of support
- Programs and Sports teams running- Basketball teams underway, French team running Carnival (February 27th)
- PA Day (January 31st, 2025)- teachers work on report cards (come out Feb 14th)
- Feb 19th: Grade 8 night at NDSS
- Immunization notices go home Jan 28th (suspension start happening April 8th)
- Next year's school calendar voting comes out tomorrow (timing of PA days)

V. Teacher Representative's Report: Amy Kennedy-York

- Craft Sale: kids loved it; Teachers really pleased with the SAC free table and the extra tickets
- Thank you for the Flexible Seating- has arrived and most have been handed out to the classrooms; everyone excited (kids and teachers).
- Andrea shared an email to the teachers to introduce herself regarding the Indigenous Rep role and how she can help in the classrooms to support them
- Grade 8's are excited about helping out at the dance
